Just some of what we achieved during 2015 (Review of 2015 is available on our website)

- ***To brighten up the old town centre, banners were erected on four banner poles at Channel Street Plaza and on the three banner poles within Market Place.***
- Energise Galashiels produced pop-up banners promoting a range of sporting activities to be used in various vacant window locations and for special promotions.
- ***We organised the visit of the Magnificent Organ to Galashiels in July 2015***
- Robbie Scott, a talented local artist and student at Galashiels Academy volunteered to produce a work for our 'Looking Good' initiatives. Robbie created a wonderful painting of the Braw Lad and Braw Lass crossing the River Tweed with hordes of supporters on the river bank and bridge.
- ***We led the Micro Hydro power initiative which is assessing the potential of generating power from the Mill Lade and River Gala.***

Why we need your support as a Member!

Much of what we do is achieved through the outstanding voluntary efforts of many. Some volunteers assist with one project, others are involved in several – every contribution of time and effort is greatly appreciated and help us to make a difference!

However, we also require funds. Each year, Energise Galashiels, as charitable trust, requires cash to pay premiums for Public Liability, Contents and other insurances.

Last year, we were well supported by Scottish Borders Council Rail Celebration fund which is now closed. Energise Galashiels also benefitted from grants from a local fund-raising charity with the marvellous bonus of this being matched by Santander. This allowed us to design and print the Pole Banners you see in Market Square and at the top of Channel Street and to create the special Christmas Pole Banners.

Energise Galashiels supported Galashiels Community Council who led the events and activities around the Flying Scotsman visit in May, which included window displays, buskers and bands and a choir, bouncy castles and the unique opportunity to be part of the Flying Scotsman mural being created by Chris Rutterford.

We support 100 Bands, the Creative Coathanger group and Heriot-Watt University School of Textiles & Design Students, all of whom are working hard to bring new events to the town.

Our objective from Membership is to generate sufficient core funds to deal with all our statutory obligations and to have funds available which allow us to deliver our vision.
